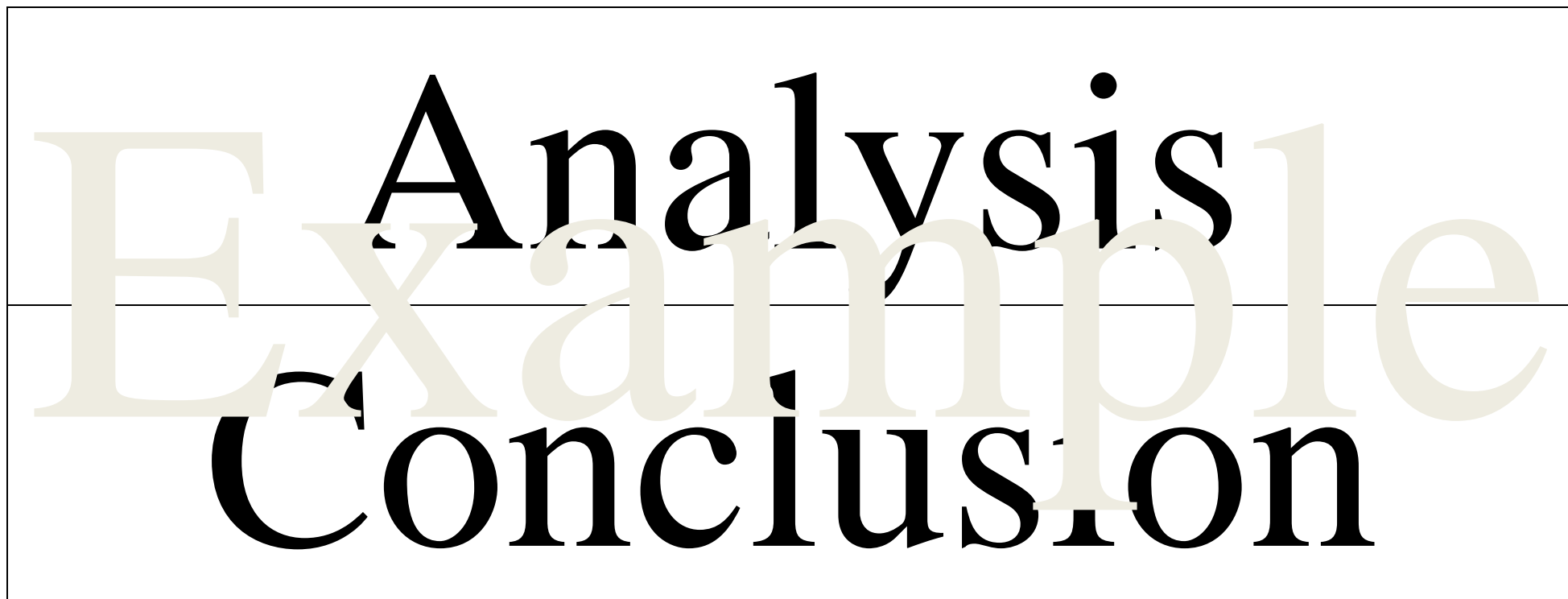
1. Create a one-column table.
